Now there is a choice of plans designed to meet your specific needs. Whether you are an Instructor or Regional Counselor who needs professional coverage or just general liability, you can choose the plan and liability limit that works best for you. The NRA Endorsed Insurance Program is available to *NRA members only and* offers two plans with optional limits:

Instructor Plan - general liability coverage only for bodily injury and/or property damage, as well as most defense costs, caused while acting as an Instructor or Regional Counselor during a seminar or instructor development workshop. Limits available include \$100,000 and \$250,000. To apply for this coverage, complete the form below.

Instructor Plus Plan - designed for Instructors or Regional Counselors who want, or need, professional liability coverage in addition to general liability. This plan offers the same coverages shown above for the Instructor Plan plus Medical expenses up to \$5,000 and professional liability coverage. Limits available include \$250,000, \$500,000, and \$1,000,000. Applications for the Instructor Plus Plan, are available online at www.NRAEndorsedInsurance.com. The instructor and Instructor Plus plans are available to NRA Certified Refuse To Be A Victim[®] Instructors and Regional Counselors with a current certification. Both plans are available only in conjunction with Excess Personal Liability which provides coverage for bodily injury or property damage caused by the use of a firearm, air gun, bow and arrow or trapping equipment.
